Note: This product is recommended for drywall only. We offer other wall mounts that are more appropriate for metal and wood surfaces.

- **1.** Select an area of drywall free from wiring and conduits and determine the position for your Recessed Wall Mount. Measure a rectangle 2-7/8" wide by 4-3/8" wide. The opening should be just large enough to accommodate the Wall Mount casing. (Illustration A)
- 2. Using a drywall utility knife, cut the rectangle out of the drywall and make sure that the depth will accommodate the depth of your Wall Mount. (Illustration B)
- **3.** The Wall Mount should fit snugly into the recessed wall, exposing only the flush back plate and belt end. Using four #10 screws [anchors recommended] secure the Back Plate to the wall. exposing only the Belt End for a clean, flush look. (Illustration C)
- **4.** To create a temporary barricade, pull the belt end out and attach it to a Beltrac post or Wall Receptacle. (Illustration D)
